Substance Abuse Treatment for Teens, Adults & Older Adults

Our outpatient treatment programs are designed to meet your needs and to help you gain tools to live the life you want and fulfill your individual potential. We develop specialized treatment plans and offer both individual and group treatment provided by highly skilled, caring professionals.

Intensive Outpatient Programs

Our IOP provides a structured and focused treatment experience that connects you with others who are working on recovery. Led by Master's level clinicians, the program is typically scheduled for 8 weeks, through completion time may vary depending on one's strengths and needs.

DUI Risk Education

We are licensed by the State of Illinois to provide DUI Risk Education classes for teens and adults. We offer services that will help an individual meet any of the levels of education and/or treatment that the Illinois Secretary of State may require.

Specialized Treatment for Heroin and Other Opioid Dependence

At PEER Services, we employ a holistic approach to treatment that allows you to receive education, training and support. Our expert team includes a physician, nurses and clinicians to help you address your needs. Since 1975, we have utilized FDA-approved medications to help adults through opioid withdrawal and towards recovery.

Early Intervention

Not all youth who are referred meet the full criteria for substance abuse or dependence. Individuals who show significant risk can attend short-term services to help enhance overall health lifestyle choices. The EI Program includes individual and group counseling and educational sessions.
